Purpose:

To provide a scholarship to a deserving high school senior who currently resides in the Oaks Historic District and who plans to pursue a college, university, or technology education.

Award:

One (1) \$1,000 scholarship, to be paid in two (2) \$500 installments and an individual certificate will be awarded to the recipient of the Oaks Historic District Scholarship by the Oaks Historic District Neighborhood Association. The first \$500 will be awarded with proof of college, university, or technological school enrollment and the second \$500 will be awarded upon proof that the recipient has completed his or her first college semester with passing grades in each class.

Criteria for Consideration:

Required:

- 1. High School senior who resides within the geographic boundaries of the Oaks Historic District; and
- 2. Whose parent(s) reside in the Oaks Historic District and those parent(s) have been active in the neighborhood association's fundraisers or other activities for the year of application, and is a current member of the Oaks Historic District Neighborhood Association; and is a
- 3. High School senior who will enroll in an accredited college, university, or technological school for the upcoming fall semester.

Preferred:

- 1. SAT or ACT scores in the top quartile
- 2. Demonstrated community involvement
- 3. Demonstrated academic scholarship; and
- 4. Demonstrated leadership
- 5. Enrollment at Lamar University or Lamar Institute of Technology in Beaumont, Texas

To Be Qualified, Applicant Must Submit:

- 1. Completed application form (attached)
- 2. Two Letters of Recommendation, discussed in application
- 3. Proof of admission to college, university, or technological school and, if available, proof of enrollment
- 4. Proof of residence in the Oaks Historic District
- 5. Proof of parent(s) participation in the Oaks Historic District Neighborhood Association and are currently active members.

Application must be post-marked by **April 30th of each calendar year**
